3. Bids: The figure quoted in the right hand column is the RESERVE PRICE for the detail lots.
4. Lots will be sent to your membership address unless you specify otherwise on the bid form.
5. This bid form must arrive by the day before the auction.
6. Sending Lots - Inland postage method used.
 - A) Up to £30.00 1st Class Post - "Certificate of Posting".
 - B) Form £30.00 to £50.00 - 1st Class Post "Signed For".
 - B) Over £50.00. - "Special Delivery".
7. Payment is due within 72 hours of receiving your lots.
8. Sending a limited blank cheque with your bids is appreciated. It will be destroyed if NO bids succeed.

- 1) **ALWAYS** describe your lots on the L & P form or in a list if sending descriptions via e.mail. Forms can be supplied, when requested.
Please send an S.A.E.
- 2) **RECEIPT OF LOTS.** If sending auction lots through the post, enclose an S.A.E. and a confirmation of receipt will be sent to confirm their safe arrival.
- 3) **DESCRIPTIONS.** Give a brief and concise description.
(Please DO NOT re-write the second chapter from "War and Peace").
 - **Always** give the date or date range, especially when looking up the Stanley Gibbons (SG) number and the catalogue value.
 - **Always** give the number of stamps in the set or on the card etc.
 - **Reserve:** The minimum RESERVE PRICE is £2.00
- 4) **VERY IMPORTANT.** Please write the description in the following order.
 - A) Country. B) Year. C) Set or Issue. D) Stanley Gibbons Number(s).
 - E) Mint, Used or C.T.O. F) Number of Items in the Lot.
- 5) **VERY IMPORTANT. PRESENTATION OF LOTS.**
The minimum size is 6" x 4" even for single stamps.
Smaller items either get mislaid or damaged.
- 6) **IMPORTANT.** Your reference number MUST BE on the back of each lot.
