- RECEIPT OF LOTS.** If sending auction lots through the post, enclose an S.A.E. and a confirmation of receipt will be sent to confirm their safe arrival.
- DESCRIPTIONS.** Give a brief and concise description. (Please DO NOT re-write the second chapter from "War and Peace").
 - Always give the date or date range, especially when looking up the Stanley Gibbons (SG) number and the catalogue value.
 - Always give the number of stamps in the set or on the card etc.
 - Reserve: The minimum RESERVE PRICE is £2.00
- VERY IMPORTANT.** Please write the description in the following order.
 - Country.
 - Year.
 - Set or Issue.
 - Stanley Gibbons Number(s).
 - Mint, Used or C.T.O.
 - Number of Items in the Lot.
- VERY IMPORTANT. PRESENTATION OF LOTS.** The minimum size is 6" x 4" even for single stamps. Smaller items either get mislaid or damaged.
- IMPORTANT.** Your reference number MUST BE on the back of each lot.

WOULD ALL MEMBERS PLEASE NOTE: I would like to remind all Buyers and Vendors that the position of Hon. Auctioneer is a voluntary position and the timings are :-
